DANE HILL PARK

Over £11,000 has been raised by members of the community and council to improve the equipment and safety of a children's play park in Disley.

Thanks to an overwhelming response, £11,564 has been raised from 175 backers including £5,190 from Cheshire East Council.

Rhiannon Adams, chair of Friends of Dane Hill Close Park, Disley, said: "We are overwhelmed by the support for this campaign from the village of Disley. Local businesses and residents gave about half of the overall money raised whilst Disley Parish Council gave £500 and Cheshire East Council gave over £5k!
