Full School uniform must be worn in lessons, on school site and walking to and from school.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION UNIFORM

- Plain royal blue cotton t-shirt with or without the school badge
- Black shadow stripe or plain black cotton shorts
- Trainers (not pumps)
- Plain black Tracksuit bottoms/leggings
- An outdoor coat (a separate coat suitable for doing PE in)
- A plain royal blue or black hoody/zip-up jacket

Additional items required only for children in Years 3, 4, 5 and 6:

- Shin pads
- Gum shield in a case
- Football socks (Navy blue or black)

Where can I purchase the items as reference on the uniform list?

To ensure that our uniform is affordable for all, most items can be bought from high street shops/supermarkets.
